NCEA

- NCEA Level 1 – 60 credits + Literacy + Numeracy
- NCEA Level 2 – 60 credits + (Literacy + Numeracy)
- NCEA Level 3 – 60 credits + (Literacy + Numeracy)
- University Entrance (UE) – NCEA Level 3 + 14+ credits in 3 UE approved subjects + UE Literacy + (Literacy + Numeracy)

Subjects

- Year 11 (Level 1) – 6 subjects – must include Maths and English
- Year 12 (Level 2) – 6 subjects – must include English
- Year 13 (Level 3) - 5 Subjects and study or 6 subjects

Vocational and Academic Pathways

- Vocational Pathway – giving you the skills and knowledge to prepare you for specific trades or careers. Police course, gateway, trades.....
- Academic Pathway – giving you the broad skills and knowledge to prepare you for further study such as university.
- There are courses today that you will see follow a vocational pathway and academic pathway. Many of the new courses for 2025 are vocational courses to give you more choice within your pathway.

Achievement and Unit Standards

- Vocational Pathways – many unit standards and less achievement standards
- Academic Pathways – mostly or all achievement standards

- Unit standards – Achieved
- Achievement Standards – Achieved, Merit Excellence

University Entrance Level 3

- University Entrance (UE) – NCEA Level 3 + 14+ credits in 3 UE approved subjects + UE Literacy + (Literacy + Numeracy)
- If University is an option you are considering you need to ensure that the majority of the courses you are taking are academic pathway courses.
- In Level 3 at least 4 academic pathway UE approved courses should be taken, it is recommended to do 5 to ensure you can achieve university entrance.

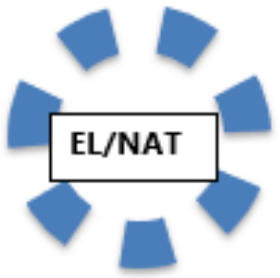
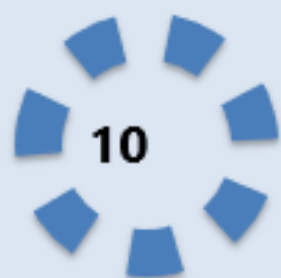
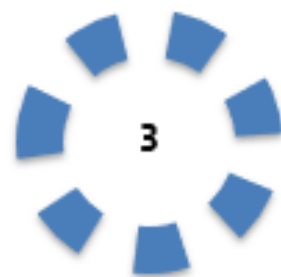
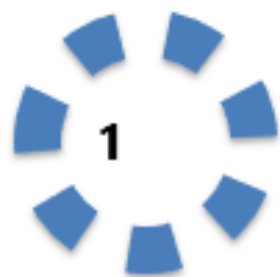
Subject Selection
